## NWAWPCS Rules

- 1 All exhibits must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society
- 2 No telephone or email entries will be accepted
- 3 All entries must be paid before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring
- 4 Animals and property will be considered as being in the exhibitor's charge
- 5 All colts and stallions, two years old and over, must be suitably bitted and led by a handler
- 6 Children and dogs must be supervised at all times
- 7 The Committee will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury owing to accident or other cause
- 8 The Committee reserves the right to postpone, alter, cancel, divide or combine without notice, any or all events
- 9 Any objection must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £25, which shall be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled
- 10 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 11 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get him/herself into the ring at the correct time
- 12 Classes will not be held up for competitors who are exhibiting in more than one section
- 13 No prize money will be given
- 14 The judge's decision is final

## Medal Awards

- 1 Bronze Medals will only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion
- 2 No animal shall be awarded more than one bronze medal in one year
- 3 Medals awarded at the Royal Welsh Show are exempted from this rule
- 4 Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society, who have paid their subscription for the current year or are Life Members, or who have submitted their name for membership and paid one annual subscription of Life Membership composition

## WPCS Ridden Classes

- 1 All exhibits must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society
- 2 Spurs must not be worn in any class
- 3 Show canes/whips are not to exceed 75 cms. In lead rein classes, only plain or leather covered canes may be used
- 4 Hard hats to the approved BSI standard MUST be worn at all times whilst mounted
- 5 An exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 6 Animals must be four years old or over
- 7 Riders of Welsh Section A, B, C & Welsh Part Bred stallions 13.2 hh and under must have attained their 12th birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 8 Riders of Welsh Section D & Welsh Part Bred stallions over 13.2 hh must have attained their 14th birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 9 Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 10 Lead rein ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle only, with lead rein attached to the noseband
- 11 First ridden ponies may be shown in any suitable bridle
- 12 No prize money will be given
- 13 Snaffle bridles only in all novice classes
- 14 The judge's decision is final

## Members' Rosettes

Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Member in each class. Competing Members must enter the ring wearing an official NWA armband or NWA badge and carrying a current year's membership card

## Junior Members' Rosettes

Junior Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Junior Member in each class. Eligible Junior Members must enter the ring wearing an official NWA Junior Members armband and carrying a current year's Junior Members membership card. Children of Family Members are not eligible for a Junior Members' Rosette

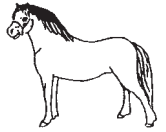
