## YOUNG HANDLERS CLASSES

### Ring 6 at 11.30 am

- Class 66 YOUNG HANDLERS - Not to have attained 14th birthday on day of Show
- Class 67 YOUNG HANDLERS - 14 birthday and over, and not to have attained 18th birthday on day of Show

#### **YOUNG HANDLERS CHAMPIONSHIP**

1st and 2nd Prizewinners from classes 66 & 67 to compete for Trophy

- Class 68 SPECIAL IN HAND GELDING CLASS  
All ages. To compete for the DRYDUN CUP

#### **NOVICE RIDDEN - to follow Young Handlers classes - SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY**

- Class 69 NOVICE RIDDEN  
Open to Sections A, B and Welsh Part Bred (13.2 hh and under), four years old and over.  
Not to have won a 1st prize up to the day of show
- Class 70 NOVICE RIDDEN  
Open to Sections C, D and Welsh Part Bred (over 13.2 hh), four years old and over.  
Not to have won a 1st prize up to the day of show

## NWAWPCS Rules

- 1 All exhibits must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society
- 2 No telephone or email entries will be accepted
- 3 All entries must be paid before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring
- 4 All colts and stallions two years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler who has attained his/her 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year
- 5 Animals and property will be considered as being in the exhibitor's charge
- 6 Children and dogs must be supervised at all times
- 7 The Committee will not in any way be responsible for loss, damage or injury owing to accident or other cause
- 8 The Committee reserves the right to postpone, alter, cancel, divide or combine without notice, any or all events
- 9 Any objection must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £25, which shall be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled
- 10 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 11 A Barren Mare is, for the purpose of this Show, a mare who has not produced a foal, dead or alive, and will not produce a foal in the current year
- 12 Foals must be 3 weeks old or over on day of Show
- 13 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get him/herself into the ring at the correct time
- 14 No refunds will be given to late-comers
- 15 Classes will not be held up for competitors who are exhibiting in more than one section
- 16 Prize money will only be awarded to Section Champions, the Ridden Champion and the Supreme Champion
- 17 The judge's decision is final

## Medal Awards

- 1 Silver Medals will only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion
- 2 No animal shall be awarded more than one Medal in one year. Medals awarded at the Royal Welsh Show are exempted from this rule
- 3 Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society, who have paid their subscription for the current year or are Life Members, or who have submitted their name for membership and paid one annual subscription or Life Membership composition

## WPCS Ridden Classes

- 1 All entries must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society
- 2 Spurs must not be worn in any class
- 3 Show canes/whips are not to exceed 75 cms. In lead rein classes, only plain or leather covered canes may be used
- 4 Hard hats to the approved BSI standard must be worn at all times whilst mounted
- 5 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 6 Animals must be four years old or over
- 7 Riders of Welsh Section A, B, C and Welsh Part Bred stallions, 13.2 hh and under, must have attained their 12th birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 8 Riders of Welsh Section D and Welsh Part Bred stallions, over 13.2 hh, must have attained their 14th birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 9 Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday prior to 1st January in the current year
- 10 Lead rein ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle only, with lead rein attached to the noseband
- 11 First ridden ponies may be shown in any suitable bridle
- 12 Snaffle bridles only may be worn in novice classes
- 13 Prize money to overall ridden champion only
- 14 The judge's decision is final

## Members' Rosettes

Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Member in each class. Competing Members must enter the ring wearing an official NWA armband or member's badge and carrying a current year's membership card

## Junior Members' Rosettes

Junior Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Junior Member in each class. Eligible Junior Members MUST enter the ring wearing an official NWA armband and carrying a current year's Junior Members membership card. Children of Family Members are not eligible for a Junior Members' Rosette

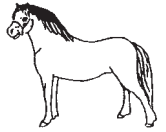
