### WELSH SECTION B

- Class 8 Yearling colt
  - Class 9 Yearling filly or gelding

  - Class 12 Mare or gelding, four years old and over
  - Class 13 Stallion, four years old and over
  - Class 14 Home bred Welsh Section B, to be exhibited by owner/breeder

The handler, aged 14 years or over, but not to have attained his/her 18th birthday on the day of the show

1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 15 & 16 to compete



## NWAWPCS In Hand Rules

- 1 All exhibits MUST be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society
- 2 No telephone or email entries will be accepted
- 3 All entry fees MUST BE PAID before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring
- 4 All colts and stallions 2 years old or over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler who has attained his/her 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year
- 5 Animals and property will be considered as being in the exhibitors' charge
- 6 Children and dogs must be supervised at all times
- 7 The Committee will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury owing to accident or other cause
- 8 The Committee reserves the right to postpone, alter, cancel, divide or combine without notice, any or all events
- 9 Any objection must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £25, which shall be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled
- 10 Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring
- 11 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get him/herself into the ring at the correct time. Sorry - no refunds will be given to late-comers
- 12 Classes will not be held up for competitors who are exhibiting in more than one section
- 13 No prize money will be given
- 14 The judge's decision is final

## Ridden Show Rules

- 1 All rules as per the BSPS 2010 rule book
  - 2 This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS
  - 3 The following classes are qualifiers for the BSPS Winter Championship Show. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners will qualify in the Novice Classes. In the mixed Height Novice Classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th will qualify. In the open classes the 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners will qualify, and the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify. In the mixed height OPEN classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prizewinners overall will qualify and the four highest place restricted animals will qualify (riders on Restricted Animals must wear an armband). Restricted animals may also be placed in the overall class and qualify for both the Open & Restricted Sections
  - 4 From the CHAPS (UK) winter restricted class, four animals may qualify from the class placings - Non-Native Horse (exceeding 15 hh) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to be ridden by the judge at the Final Non-Native Pony (15 hh and under) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to perform an individual show at the Final Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob type Horse (exceeding 14.2 hh) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to be ridden by the judge at the Final Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob type Pony (14.2 hh and under) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to perform an individual show at the Final
- Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championship and must be ridden by BSPS members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before, who are allowed seven days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the Championship they qualify for

## Members' Rosettes

NWA Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Member in each class. Competing Members MUST enter the ring wearing an official NWA armband and carrying a current membership card

## Junior Members' Rosettes

NWA Junior Members' Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Junior Member in each class. Eligible Junior Members must enter the ring wearing an official NWA red Junior Members armband and carrying a current Junior Members membership card  
Children of Family Members are not eligible for a Junior Members' Rosette

- Class 2 BSPP MIXED HEIGHT CLASS FOR NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONIES not exceeding 153 cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride
- Class 3 BSPP MIXED NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE/SHOW HUNTER over 146 cms but not exceeding 158 cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year

## Not before 10:00 am

- Class 4 BSPP MIXED HEIGHT CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW PONIES not exceeding 148 cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride
- Class 5 BSPP MIXED HEIGHT CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW HUNTER PONIES not exceeding 153 cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride
- Class 6 BSPP MIXED OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE/SHOW HUNTER exceeding 146 cms but not exceeding 158 cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Class 7 CHAPS (UK) WINTER RESTRICTED QUALIFIER  
Judges will not ride any exhibit in the qualifiers, but judges will ride the Non-Native horses and the Native/Traditional/Cob type horses at the final

- Class 9 THE BSPP "HERITAGE" MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) LEAD REIN Mares or geldings, 4 years or over, not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Class 10 THE BSPP "HERITAGE" MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) FIRST RIDDEN Mares or geldings, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128 cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year

- Class 13 THE BSPP "HERITAGE" MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN New Forest and Connemara ponies, 4 years old and over. Riders any age
- Class 14 THE BSPP "HERITAGE" MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN Fells, Dales, Highland and Welsh Section D ponies, 4 years old and over. Riders any age
